## Computer Lab

## Parent & Child Counselling

For providing an insight into successful parenting & providing solution to parent as well as students in the challenges faced by them in the process of education, AEC arranges for professional counsellors, to provide free counselling to the parents & students on the regular basis.



## Closed Circuit T.V.

At AEC our classrooms are under close supervision of the Principal through a network of Closed Circuit TVs, so that the teachers & their teaching method are under constant supervision.



## Health & Sanitation

AEC has installed water cooler & filters to provide the children with clean & cold drinking water throughout the year. Children at AEC will be specifically groomed about general health & sanitation in their lifestyle. We also arrange for wellness camp for our students well being.

# POWER HOUR

Power Hour is the time devoted to various activities for young and curious minds at Archies Education Centre. We run various clubs at this HOUR like Environment Club, Literary Club, Cultural Club etc. Activities like Taekwondo, Archery and Adventure Sports are a significant part of our POWER HOUR. This HOUR was designed to cater the intrapersonal and interpersonal skills of our students keeping in mind the theory of Multiple Intelligence focusing on the holistic development of the children.

# REGISTRATION, ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

## Pre School Section (Toddlers, PG, Nur. & Prep)

Registrations for admission start from the last week of December. Once the child has been registered he or she has to appear for an interview. On satisfactory clearance, the child is admitted to the school. The age limit for the admissions is as follows:

**Toddlers:** 2 years and above.

**Play Group:** 3 years and above.

**Nursery:** 4 years and above.

**Prep:** 5 years and above.

## Junior Section (I To VIII)

The registrations for admission begin in the last week of December every year. The age limit is 5 and half years and above for Class 1 and a difference of 1 year for every class respectively as on 1st of April of the year of admission. Once registered, the child has to appear for a written test in the following subjects:

• **English Language**

• **Math**

• **Hindi**

• **Science (VI to VIII)**

Admissions are based purely on merit performance of the admission test. The merit list for admissions is displayed on the school notice board after a week of the admission test.



## WITHDRAWALS

A student may be expelled from school in case of any misconduct or breach of the school discipline. The school reserves the right to do so without assigning a reason whatsoever. A student may withdraw his/her name from the school at any time provided he/she submits an application a month before. Fee for the full quarter must be paid in the case of withdrawal in the middle of a term. No claim for refund of fee deposited will be entertained under any circumstances.

**GIRLS :** Neon green shirt with blue skirt, blue socks with white stripes, black velcro shoes (action shoes) along with an apron and a napkin  
(to be carried by the child)

**BOYS :** Neon green shirt with half blue pants, blue socks with white stripes, black velcro shoes (action shoes) along with an apron and a napkin (to be carried by the child)

### Winter:

**GIRLS :** Red full sleeves shirt with woollen trouser, grey and red woollen jacket with monogram, blue socks with white stripes, black velcro shoes (action shoes) along with an apron and a napkin (to be carried by the child)

**BOYS :** Red full sleeves shirt with woollen trouser, grey and red woollen jacket with monogram, blue socks with white stripes, black velcro shoes (action shoes) along with an apron and a napkin (to be carried by the child)



# SCHOOL UNIFORM

## Junior Section (I to VIII)

### Summer :

GIRLS : Half sleeves blue stripes shirt with school monogram, blue skirt, school belt, school tie, blue socks with white stripes, black shoes, black cycling shorts.

BOYS : Half sleeves blue stripes shirt with school monogram, blue half pants (I to IV), school belt, school tie, blue socks with white stripes, full pants (V to VIII)black shoes.

### Winter:

GIRLS : Full sleeves blue stripes shirt with school monogram, blue skirt, school belt, school tie, navy blue half sweater, navy blue blazer with monogram, blue stockings, blue socks with white stripes, black shoes, black cycling shorts.

BOYS : Full sleeves blue stripes shirt with school monogram, blue full pants, school belt, school tie, navy blue half sweater, navy blue blazer with monogram, blue socks with white stripes, black shoes.

BOYS & GIRLS : House t-shirt with blue tracks pants, white socks with blue stripes, canvas shoes.



# SCHOOL FEES

The academic session begins in the month of April every year and fee is collected quarterly in advance up to the month of March at the end of the session.

The fee should be deposited in advanced between 1st and 15th of every first month of the quarter starting from April at the designated bank, Failing which attract a fine of Rs. 50/- till 30th of the month. However if the fee remains unpaid for more than one month. the name of the child shall be struck off the rolls of the school. Re-admission, if allowed, will be considered only on the merits of the case, however in that case full payment of all outstanding dues, including late payment fines and re-admission fee of Rs. 1000/- will be collected.

The details for the fees structure can be had from the school office.

# ARRAY OF ACTIVITIES

Schools today are no longer confined to classroom instructions. We believe that school is much more than academic lessons and qualifications. Many of the most important lessons are those which students learn as a part of team games, cross fertilizations of ideas, competitions and collaborative work. JODOGYAN : This curriculum induces good mathematical skills in our students and provides enormous material resource for our students to perform various activities using Ganit Mala, Aakar Parivar, Jodo Blocks, Number Sticks etc. It promotes inquiry based learning with their specially designed modules.





KARADI PATH : Karadi Path is a reading programme focusing solely on spoken, reading & listening skills of young learners. This programme provides an immersive audio-visual learning environment for children from non-english backgrounds to enhance their vocabulary and oratory skills. Karadi path methodology is an indigenously developed language learning process that is revolutionising the way language proficiency is achieved in schools.
